**Constitution**  
**(Registered as a Society under the Societies Registration Act, 1960)**  
**Memorandum of association**

1. NAME OF THE SOCIETY :

The name of the society shall be 'Chinmaya Educational society', Solan (hereinafter referred to as CES).

2. ADDRESS OF THE SOCIETY :

Chinmaya Vidyalaya  
Nauni, Solan (H.P.) 173230

3. AREA OF FUNCTIONING OF THE SOCIETY :

The registered office of the society shall be situated at Solan, (H.P.) 173230 and its area of functioning will be Himachal Pradesh State.

4. The objects for which the "Chinmaya Educational Society" is established are :-

(a) To provide, establish, endow, maintain control and manage the Chinmaya Vidyalaya at Nauni, Solan (H.P.) for the children of the employees of Dr. Y. S. Parmar University of Horticulture & Forestry, local students, floating and transferable population and to do all acts and things necessary for or conducive to the promotion of the CES.

(b) To organise and promote graduate level and higher level education in all streams and other technical and non-technical education related to agricultural, Horticulture & Forestry and other technologies available in the university complex Nauni, Solan (H.P.).

(c) To construct, maintain and manage the schools for orphans, other Educational Institutes, Dispensary, hospitals, diagnostic centres, community centres and to provide medical relief and medical aid to the needy ones.

(d) To develop infrastructure and environment to promote and facilitate educational values and learning environment thereby progressively achieving higher quality levels of education.

(e) To train students for a life of dedication to the service of motherland, respect to the elders and constitution of India

(f) To acquire by lease, hire, purchase, contract or agreement or otherwise buildings, lands and easement rights of common playgrounds, parks and other property, moveable or immovable.

(g) To constitute Boards, committees, or other bodies as may be deemed fit from time to time and prescribe their powers, functions tenure etc.

(h) To promote, arrange, organise and/or hold exhibitions, lectures, seminars, symposia,



workshops, classes, debates, conferences, tours, excursions and other functions for the furtherance of the objects of CES.

- (i) To preserve, promote and disseminate the educational and cultural heritage of India and encourage its enrichment as expounded by the great seers and acharyas of India in the light of modern development.
- (j) To establish, develop, maintain and manage hostels for the residence of the students as are categorised under clause 4(a).
- (k) To build, construct, maintain and manage in all respects houses, buildings, ashrams and alter, extend, improve, enlarge or modify the same including any existing property, moveable or immoveable and provide and equip the same with light, water and necessary amenities or facilities for the use of such property.
- (l) To maintain a Fund at Naini, Solan, to which shall be credited :-
  - (1) All money provided by D.C.S.T., the State Govt. of H.P. and the Central Government.
  - (2) All money received by Chinmaya Educational Society (CES) by way of grants, gifts, donations, benefactions, bequests or transfers, and
  - (3) All fees and charges received by the C.V.
  - (4) All money received by CES in any other manner from any other source.
- (m) To fix and arrange to collect such fees and other charges as may be laid down by the Rules and Regulation under them.
- (n) To deposit all money credited to the Fund in the nationalised Banks or to invest in such a manner as CES may decide from time to time.
- (o) To borrow or raise money with or without securities or on the security of a mortgage hypothecation or pledge over all or any of the immoveable or movable properties belonging to the CES or in other manner whatsoever.
- (p) To draw accept, endorse and discount cheques, notes or other negotiable instruments and for this purpose to sign, execute and deliver such assurances writings and documents and deeds as may be necessary for the purpose of CES.
- (q) To solicit, obtain or accept subscriptions, donations, grants, gifts, devices, bequests and all kinds of property moveable or immoveable with or without any special terms or conditions not being consistent with the objects of CES, including the condition that the name of the donors may be exhibited as desired by him or them.
- (r) To make payments or grants or donations for any Charitable or useful purpose and to undertake social welfare and cultural activities.















- (s) To do all such things as may be considered necessary, incidental, or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects of the CES.
- (t) The income and property of CES shall be applied towards the promotion of the objects thereof as set forth in the Memorandum of Association. No part of income and property of the CES shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividends, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to the persons who are at any time, or have been members of the CES, core committees, DCST or the Management Committee of the CV or to any of them or to any persons claiming through them provided that nothing therein contained shall prevent to the payment, in good faith or remuneration to any members thereof or other persons in return for any service rendered to CES or of travelling allowances, halting or similar other charges.
- (u) To establish local Chinmaya Mission Unit and enrol wards of the students and the willing residents of the area as its members to get the benefit of the free service of the Mission. A Mission Bulletin informing Vidyalaya programme will be sent free to the enrolled members every month against their annual membership fee.
5. The names, address and occupation of the first members of the CES to whom its affairs and management is entrusted are as following as required under Section (21) of the Societies registration Act of 1960.
